There were more than 50 participants- Urmul Natural Dye Cluster, Bikaner had 20 women artisans who attended the online program from their Common Facility Centre (CFC).

A few key highlights emerged out of the event. Smt. Urvashi ben and Giraben from the Bamboo Crafts Cluster in Tapi, Gujarat shared that the Cluster Development Initiative in their district has curtailed rural-to-urban migration. Ms. Bhagwati Devi from Udala Palmarosa and Lemongrass Oil Cluster shared that she contested and won the elections to the local body for women's empowerment in her village. Smt. Laxmi Devi from Urmul Natural Dye Cluster, Bikaner shared that her cluster utilizes the colors available in their natural environment for dyeing, thus, promoting sustainability.
